Waste Clearance at former Waste4Fuel site underway

We are delighted to confirm that work is once again underway to clear the remaining waste at the former Waste4Fuel site in Cornwall Drive.

To confirm, Bromley Council has appointed Veolia to remove the waste and the Council and Veolia will be working closely together to ensure this major operation runs smoothly. The recommencement of the removal work follows the procurement of additional funding from the Government to deal with and treat the technically contaminated waste material which was discovered in a seam of rubbish towards the bottom of the stack, including combusted/melted plastics and heavier based carbon materials.

We expect this final phase of the removal of the estimated remaining 9,000 tonnes of waste on site to take **approximately 2 months once we are fully operational**. Working hours for the project are the same as previously.

We will be doing what we can to minimise possible disruption resulting from the works, mindful of both local residents and local traffic conditions. Thank you for your co-operation regarding parking in Cornwall Drive. Please continue to park as closely as possible to the side of the road and away from the junction until the completion of these works, bearing in mind the size of the vehicles that will be using it to gain access.

To reduce risk of the waste from catching fire and other nuisance factors such as dust, litter and smells, the waste will be sprayed with a light dusting of water. A water-based deodorant will be sprayed to reduce emitting smells. Low noise generators will be used too and Veolia will continue to work closely with the London Fire Brigade at all times.

We will contact you to update you about progress, most probably to let you know when we expect the final waste to be removed from the site. Should you have any questions or concerns regarding the operation, please visit www.bromley.gov.uk/waste4fuel or call 020 8313 4575.

The Environment Agency will continue to monitor the waste removal operation and will be on site to make sure that this is done in accordance with the appropriate regulations. If you have concerns, call them on 0800 80 70 60.
