Theft from sheds and garages in Bexley account for 1/3 of all reported burglaries.

Secure access to your shed/garage by walls and fences.

Have you visibly marked the contents of your shed? Make a note of the serial numbers and photograph valuable items and garden ornaments.

External security day and night lighting is a deterrent.

Doors of sheds require attention. Use strong pad bars and locks. Fit a padlock to your garage door. Fit grills across windows.

Use coach bolts of non-return security screws to secure your door hinges.
Chain cycles, mowers, ladders and tools TOGETHER
